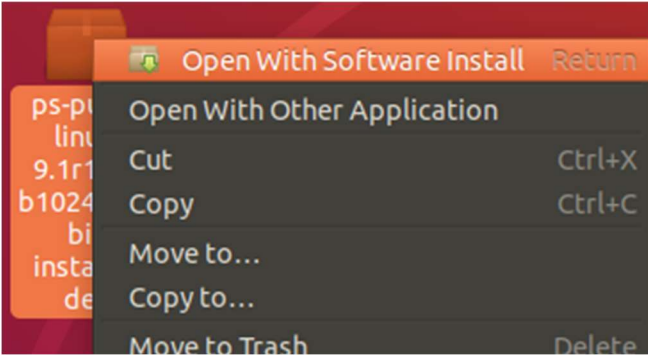


Ubuntu 18/20 Installation and configuration instructions

Download and open the installation package with Software install



Select Install, enter your computer password to complete the install



Launch PulseUI



Click the + to add a new VPN connection



Give the connection a name and use vpn.vanderbilt.edu as the server URL. Click Add.







Enter your VUNetID and password, then select Connect.




